



Wiltshire Police has set up its own dog watch scheme to help reassure dog owners across Wiltshire. After the past few months there has been a rising perception and concern that more dog thefts and attempted dog thefts are taking place across the country. Here in Swindon and Wiltshire, so far in 2021, we haven't had any reports of dogs being physically stolen. However, we have received reports of a handful of attempted dog thefts which we are investigating.
